

PARENTAL CONTRACT
YWCA of Central Maine Summer Camp 2018

Agreement:

This document is an official agreement between the YWCA Child Care Program and the parent or guardian of the child listed in this document. One important goal of the YWCA Child Care department is to ensure the safety and security of children in our care at all times. For this reason, parents and guardians must follow the steps outlined in this contract. The YWCA does not discriminate by race, age, sex, gender identification, religion, family composition, ethnicity, or sexual orientation.

Parental Agreements:

Please read and initial the following to indicate that you have read, understand and agree to this contract and that you have received a copy of the Handbook, read it and have had an opportunity to ask questions:

1. _____ I give my child, _____, permission to walk with a YWCA staff person to and from a 2 mile radius for parks and playgrounds or any other walking destination on a daily basis for the purposes of program activities.
2. _____ I understand that tuition is **prepaid** and that if I fail to pay on time, my child will not be able to continue in the program.
3. _____ I understand that I can ask to speak with the Summer Camp Director in private for any concerns regarding camp activities and that I may contact the Early Learning and Youth Services Director to discuss YWCA policies and rules associated with the Summer Camp Programs overall.
4. _____ I understand that if my child is late for a field trip departure time, I will be responsible for his/her care for the day.
5. _____ I do assume all monetary responsibility if my child damages YWCA property or any property while the YWCA program is at an off-site trip. I will pay all fees that are incurred due to this damage.
6. _____ I agree that I have read the attached YWCA handbook, including the Discipline Policy, with my child, and that we are willing to adhere to the rules and consequences listed in this handbook.
7. _____ I agree and understand that I may not drop off my child any earlier than 7:30 AM (unless I have registered for extended care) or pick-up later than 5:30 PM each day. I also understand that if I am unable to pick up by 5:30 PM, that I will be charged a late fee of \$10. I also understand that if I abuse this policy, it could result in my child's expulsion for summer camp.
8. _____ I give my child permission to attend the weekly field trips and ride on the bus that the YWCA has contracted to transport the children to and from the chosen destination.
9. _____ I understand that my child will not be able to purchase any food at the YWCA or on field trips.
10. _____ The YWCA must make reasonable modifications to their policies and practices to include children, parent and guardians with disabilities, unless to do so would be a fundamental alteration of their program.
11. _____ I will provide my child a water bottle, two snacks, sunscreen, extra clothes, a bathing suit and towel as well as toe-covered shoes for camp each day.
